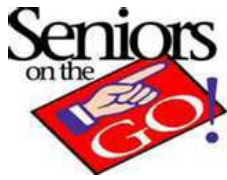
January Recap

Upcoming Trips

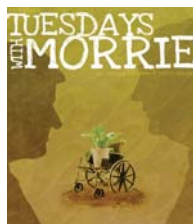
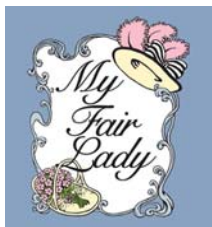


Thursday, March 24
